

Expression of Interest: WCHN Patient Care Ethics Committee member

The Women's and Children's Health Network (WCHN) is seeking to appoint two enthusiastic and committed members to the Patient Care Ethics Committee (PCEC). The available positions are specifically required to fill both a medical vacancy (doctor) in either paediatrics or surgical services and a nursing/midwifery vacancy in WABS.

The PCEC is a clinical ethics committee that is dedicated to providing independent advice to clinicians and clinical teams about ethical issues pertaining to patient care and general matters of ethical concern.

To be eligible for these positions candidates must meet the following selection criteria:

- Be a WCHN employee
- Have a genuine interest in clinical ethical issues
- Have an excellent understanding of privacy and confidentiality
- Be available to attend at least six scheduled meetings a year
- Be available at call to contribute to the discussion of urgent individual cases or issues.
