

Pregnant woman requires specialist obstetric advice

Level 4

Level 4
Capacity to provide safe care for the woman with a singleton pregnancy or a twin pregnancy with 'low risk' factors and/or minor complications ≥ 34 weeks gestation.

Level 5 and 6

Level 5
Capacity to provide safe care for the woman with 'low – high' risk factors with a singleton or twin pregnancy at ≥ 32 weeks gestation, including the care for most medical conditions and pregnancy related illnesses.

Level 6
Capacity to provide comprehensive multidisciplinary management of the 'low - high risk' pregnant women at any gestation and including any higher order multiple pregnancy

Level 6

FETAL ANOMALY

Fetal congenital malformation requiring surveillance +/- intervention
Fetal 'hospice' care
Fetal cardiac arrhythmias
Fetal hydrops
Inherited fetal endocrine anomalies requiring transplacental therapy
Referral based on ADACS involvement
Fetal congenital malformations requiring multi-speciality input and birth at WCH

CURRENT/PREVIOUS PREGNANCY COMPLICATION

Severe early IUGR requiring extended fetal doppler / cardiac function / biophysical assessment
Anti-Ro and/or Anti-La antibodies
Rhesus and other blood group incompatibilities (titre $\geq 1:16$ or previously affected fetus/neonate)
Platelet incompatibilities (previously affected fetus/neonate)
Primary infection or seroconversion with toxoplasmosis, cytomegalovirus, parvovirus, listeriosis
Previous ≥ 2 spontaneous (non-iatrogenic) pre-term births < 32 weeks gestation
Previous ≥ 2 Perinatal deaths (IUFD, NND)

COMPLEX MULTIPLE PREGNANCY

Monochorionic / Monoamniotic Twin Pregnancy
Monochorionic / Diamniotic (MC/DA) Twin Pregnancy with Twin-Twin Transfusion Syndrome (TTTS) or discordant growth/nuchal translucency
Triplet and Higher order multiple pregnancy
Delayed interval deliveries

ADACS FOLLOW UP

Stillbirth
IUFD
Fetal anomaly

SEVERE MATERNAL MEDICAL CONDITIONS

Antiphospholipid syndrome
Sickle Cell Anaemia or G6PD deficiency
Ehler – Danlos Disease
Cardiac disease (New York Heart Association Classification Grade III or IV)
Maternal transplant
Renal failure with dialysis
Maternal current malignancy
HIV

PRE-PREGNANCY COUNSELLING

Pre-conception women with conditions listed in MFM5
Pre-conception women with previous fetal anomaly and possible recurrence

EARLY PREGNANCY CARE COORDINATION

Women already known to MFM unit who require coordinated early / tertiary pregnancy care including focused morphology scanning
